



In this recital, John Solomon Collins will be performing three song cycles by Black composers: *Nightsongs* by H. Leslie Adams (b. 1932), *Four Songs* by Margaret Bonds (1913-1972), and *3 Lieder für Bariton und Klavierbegleitung*, Op. 20 by Robert Owens (1925-2017). *Nightsongs* was composed by Adams in 1961 and features text by African-American writers Langston Hughes, Leslie Morgan Collins, Gloria Douglass Johnson, Clarissa Scott Delany, and James Weldon Johnson. *Four Songs* features text by the prominent writer and feminist Edna St. Vincent Millay. *3 Lieder* features text by Nobel Prize winner Hermann Hesse.
