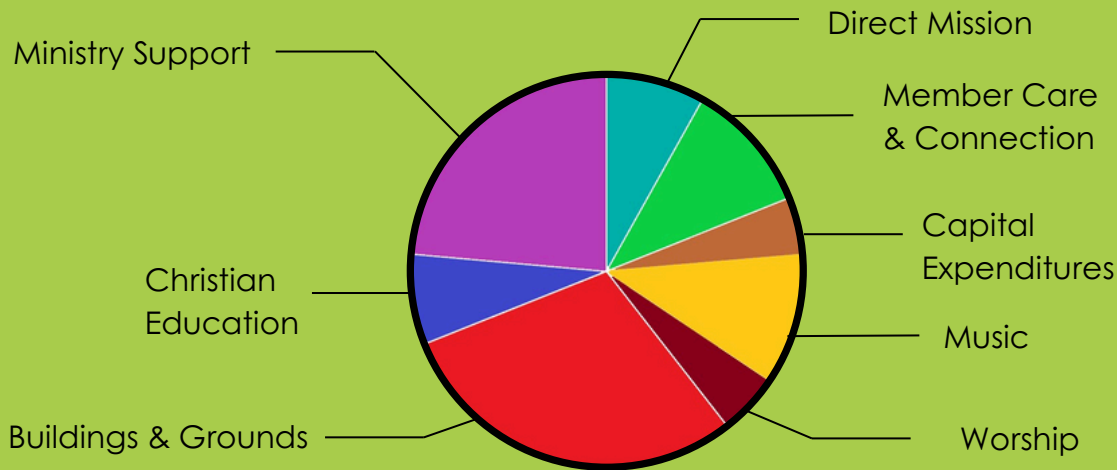


How Are Your Pledged Gifts Used?
