

Upcoming Adult Education

The Bradley Hills Adult Education Lay Ministry provides sessions each Sunday from 9:15-10:15 a.m. *Childcare is provided.*

January 5 - Prior to Dan Brown's novel, <u>The Da Vinci Code</u>, which suggests that Mary Magdalene was the wife of Jesus and carried Jesus' bloodline, Mary Magdalene was remembered primarily as the sinful woman (euphemism for prostitute) who was healed by Jesus and became one of his followers. Few people think of Mary Magdalene as the first witness to the resurrection of Jesus.

Based on the works of Cynthia Bourgeault and John Beverley Butcher, Associate Pastor Denise Diaab will examine Mary Magdalene's role as an "apostolic leader, teacher, and spiritual master" and her contribution to Christianity.

January 12 - The Living History and Beauty of Bradley Hills Sanctuary: Much of the modern 1960s design and spiritual symbolism of Bradley Hills Presbyterian Church is steeped in the designs of old Gothic cathedrals, medieval churches, and temples. Corky Hicky, Steve Fox, and Rosanna Morrison will open Bradley Hills' 70th-anniversary celebration with newly developed colorful videos, photos, and history that bring to life Christian spiritual symbolism in the sanctuary's design. This tour will include the background and interpretation of the more recent additions of the Sanctuary's Resurrection Window, Pentecost Window, Columbarium, Baptismal Font, Apostles cushions in the Chancel, and the liturgical banners that adorn the Sanctuary and help explain and interpret the Presbyterian Church's liturgical calendar.

January 19 and 26: Aging: Recognizing the Phases, Tasks, and Personality Factors that Contribute to Successful Aging. The Adult Aging Stage (starting at 55) is the longest developmental stage of our lives. Before the changes in the 20th century, we were lucky to live to 50, but with the medical advances curing many illnesses like pneumonia, we live to 80 plus and even longer in the Far East. The January 19 session will address longevity issues, the definition of aging, and its three developmental phases. Dr. Venus Masselam will help us recognize the tasks each phase requires for adaptation. The January 26 session will continue with this description and elaborate further on the personality factors that enable adaptation and physical and mental health while also recognizing the strengths and challenges brought by contemporary culture. Outdated notions continue to be considered based solely on chronological age rather than assessing the reality of one's physical, social, mental, and emotional well-being. Key factors such as relationships, retirement, and housing must be evaluated on one's physical, social, mental, and emotional well-being. Participants of all ages will benefit by attending these sessions and learning how to assess relationships, whether dealing with parents, spouses, or themselves.

Perhaps you may be looking for a church home. A community in which to connect with other families, help your children learn religious traditions, develop an understanding of and relationship with God, and a fellowship to support you as you grow in faith.
