**April 6 and April 13 - Short Stories by Jesus: The Enigmatic Parables of a Controversial Rabbi by Amy Jill Levine.** During this Lenten season we will focus on unique aspects of Christ's unique ministry with two discussions led by Dianne Whitaker, Adult Education Lay Ministry leader,

Dr. Amy-Jill Levine is the Rabbi Stanley M. Kessler Distinguished Professor of New Testament and Jewish Studies at Hartford International University for Religion and Peace.
