

## Preview of April 20

Join Us for Worship on Easter Sunday

MUSIC NOTE | The music gathered into that vast compilation known as the Mass in B minor spans more than three decades of J.S. Bach's career. Bach himself never heard it from beginning to end, and the work remained unperformed in its entirety for over a century after Johann Sebastian prepared the final stage of his manuscript between August 1748 and October 1749. Not until almost the middle of the following century was a complete edition of the Mass published. Like many another work by Bach, it might have fallen into oblivion all too easily. In fact, the Mass in B minor also stands apart within the context of Bach's modus operandi when writing sacred music, which normally was geared toward pragmatic liturgical use. Bach seems to have conceived the Mass as a grand, "abstract" compilation – as an artistic and spiritual testament (perhaps a personal appeal to, or a gift for, God?)—although he did subdivide the score in such a way that it could be performed either in whole or in part. The *Agnus dei* is near the conclusion of the work, and is notable for his chromaticism, lyricism, and beauty.






