**Supporting Refugee Resettlement** | With our members' volunteer and financial support, the **Interfaith Refugee Family Support Initiative** has helped resettle refugee families over the last 8 years in co-operation with resettlement agencies such as Lutheran Social Services (LSS). In addition, we have set up 9 apartments for newly arrived refugee families ourselves and volunteered with **Homes Not Borders** to set up many more.

The abrupt termination of federal financial support for refugee resettlement has led to chaos and hardship among newly-arrived refugees. Our Interfaith Refugee Family Support Initiative is appealing to our congregations to help bridge the financial gap left by the funding cutoff. Most funds collected will be used to support refugees through Homes Not Borders, a registered 501 (c) (3) organization. Some funds may be used to provide direct support to individual refugee families who need assistance.

**Music Note** | Healey Willan was born in England in 1880 and his early musical world was that of the Victorian English church, characterized by a fondness for plainsong and conservative harmonies. Although Willan came to Canada in 1913 as Head of Theory at the Toronto Conservatory, he is particularly known for his work as organist-choirmaster at St. Mary Magdalene's in Toronto. His compositional style and approach to choral training remained "British" to the end of his days, characterized by a clear and simple posture: "Music has been my chief delight," he said, "and if at any time I have been able to share this delight with others, I am content." The anthem **Rise up, my love, my fair one** is from his *Three Lady Motets to the Virgin Mary* and is among his most widely performed works. Replete with fluid rhythms, pleasing harmonies, and gentle chant-like melodies, *Rise up* serves as a good representation of his liturgical output.

**Set Me As a Seal** - an excerpt from *A New Creation*, this anthem is one of the most heart-felt settings of the biblical text from the Song of Solomon. Clausen composed this piece at his wife's hospital bedside after childbirth. Musically, the work employs sweet harmonies, triple rhythms, and a simple-yet-effective ABA form.
