

April 13 - Short Stories by Jesus: The Enigmatic Parables of a Controversial Rabbi by Amy Jill Levine. During this Lenten season we will focus on unique aspects of Christ's unique ministry with two discussions led by Dianne Whitaker, Adult Education Lay Ministry leader,

Join Dianne Whitaker for a video presentation and discussion of the parables of Jesus. World-renowned New Testament scholar Dr. Amy Jill Levine discusses the Jewish tradition of short stories as a teaching tool with an emphasis on the provocative and disturbing nature of Jesus's parables. Dr. Amy-Jill Levine is the Rabbi Stanley M. Kessler Distinguished Professor of New Testament and Jewish Studies at Hartford International University for Religion and Peace.

We will conclude Dr. Levine's analysis of the parables of Jesus with the Parable of the Widow and the Judge. Dr. Levine leans into the power of disturbing stories. The concluding parable looks at the meaning of justice. What is God's justice versus human justice?



**Music Note** | Alice Parker has enjoyed an extraordinarily prolific career as an arranger, conductor, and teacher. Educated at Smith College and the Juilliard School, Parker is closely associated with Robert Shaw, the two collaborating on nearly 250 arrangements of folk songs, spirituals, hymns, and songs. While many of these works bear both Mr. Shaw and Ms. Parker's names, the musical work was almost solely Parker's, Shaw serving as editor and publisher. **Come And Taste** is a rarity in that it bears Parker's name alone, and is a haunting rendition of an old Appalachian tune.
