



#### Adult Education - December

**December 7** | A Child is Born: Join Carol Starr and Jean Dudek as we share a special Advent perspective. Using resources from Amy Jill Levine (Distinguished Professor of New Testament, Rabbi Stanley M. Kessler Distinguished Professor of New Testament and Jewish Studies at Hartford International University for Religion and Peace and University Professor of New Testament and Jewish Studies Emerita at Vanderbilt University), we will place the story of Jesus' birth within the context of other miraculous births in scripture, shedding light on important layers of meaning and rich interpretations that have otherwise been overlooked.

**December 14** | Finding Hope Amidst Despair: There are textbook definitions of hope, notably "cherish a desire with anticipation," but we all tend to harbor very personal objects of hope. We are living in a period when hope is threatened. The members of our panel neither mint hope nor nurse its growth on trees, but will offer personal reflections on hope and be eager to hear some of yours. May we hope that you will attend? Panel members include Venus Masselam, Rob Bamberger, Michael Gibson, Susan Gibeson and they will encourage participation from the audience.

**December 21** | Christmas at Bradley Hills: Sharing Wonders and Miracles of the Past and Hopes for the Future. Spread nostalgia, hope, and cheer! Join longtime and more recent members as we share highlights of past Christmas celebrations and services at Bradley Hills, along with hopes for this and future celebrations. Don't miss this opportunity to extend Christmas greetings to those within our community.

Olive Oil Ministry | The Olive Oil Ministry is an all volunteer ecumenical project of more than 25 congregations in the greater Washington, DC region, which supports the Palestinian agricultural sector. The sales of olive oil and related products generate income for Palestinian families in the West Bank and Gaza, promote peace and justice, and raise awareness of the struggles in Gaza and the West Bank.

Sale of olive oil and related products will be held in Covenant Hall each Sunday between the two services through 21 December. Two varieties of olive oil, one mild and one zesty, are offered as well as olive oil soap, olive or tomato tapenade, and packages of za'atar (a spice blend of dried herbs). Most of the olive oil and other products are produced by al-'Ard Agriproducts Company in Nablus, and many qualify for organic and/or fair-trade certifications.
